Interview Method: Telephone.

Population effectively sampled: All Muslims aged 16+ in GB

Sampling Procedure

The sample was randomly generated via ICM's regular omnibus service of all telephone accessible adults in Great Britain.

ICM conducts a random telephone survey among a representative sample of the whole population twice every week. On each of such survey ICM asked respondents which religion they follow. By this method ICM were able to identify Muslim people. Attempts were made to re-contact all these people and further questions were put to them.
